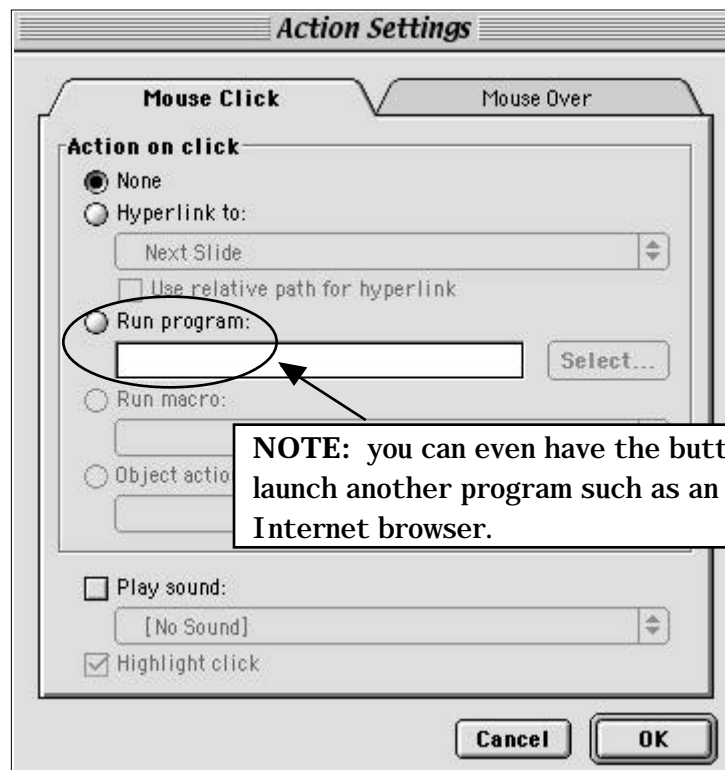
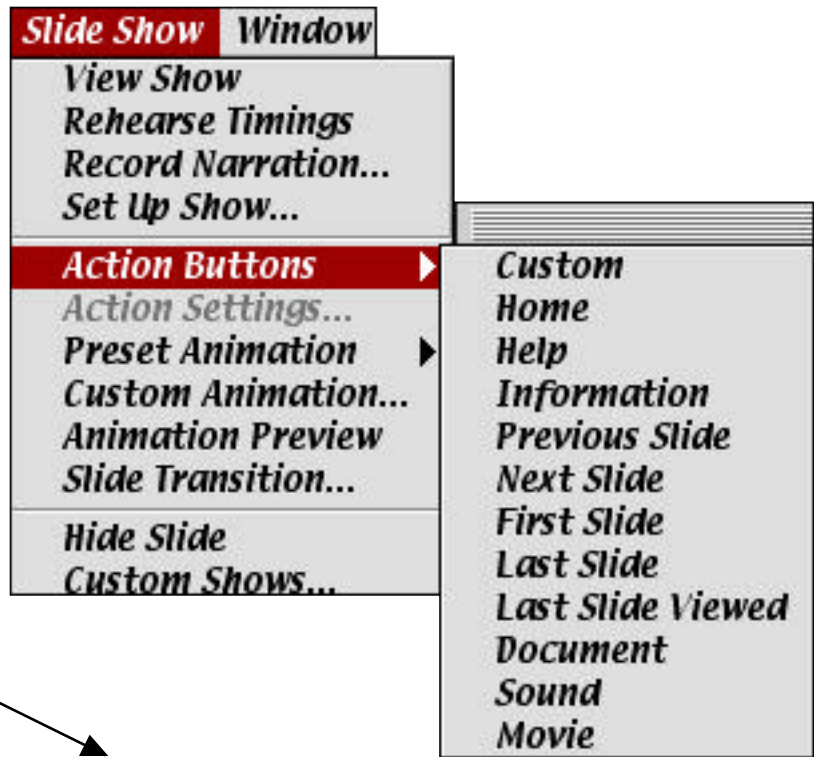
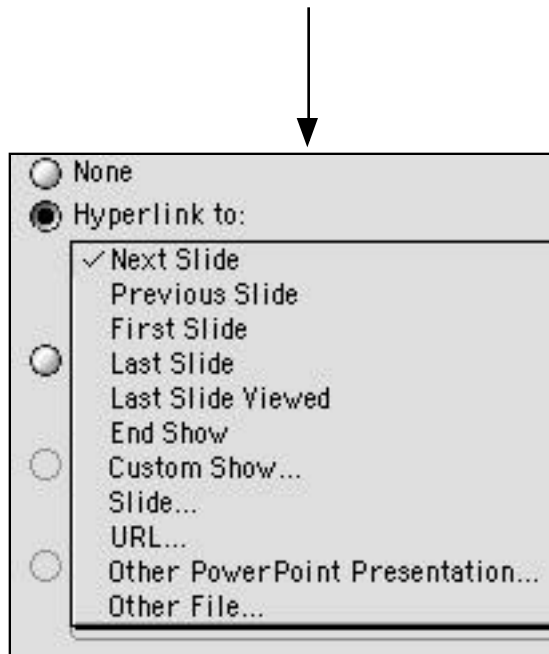


1. Go to the **Slide Show** Menu.
2. From **Action Buttons** select **Custom**.
3. Choosing **Custom** seems to work best if going from one slide to another slide.
4. A cross appears on the screen.
5. Draw a rectangle where there is an empty space or draw a rectangle over a graph or text.
6. The **Action Settings** window appears.
7. Click on **Play sound:** button if you want a sound when you click the button you are creating.
8. Click on the **Hyperlink to:** radio button to direct the button to another slide, file, or **PowerPoint** presentation.

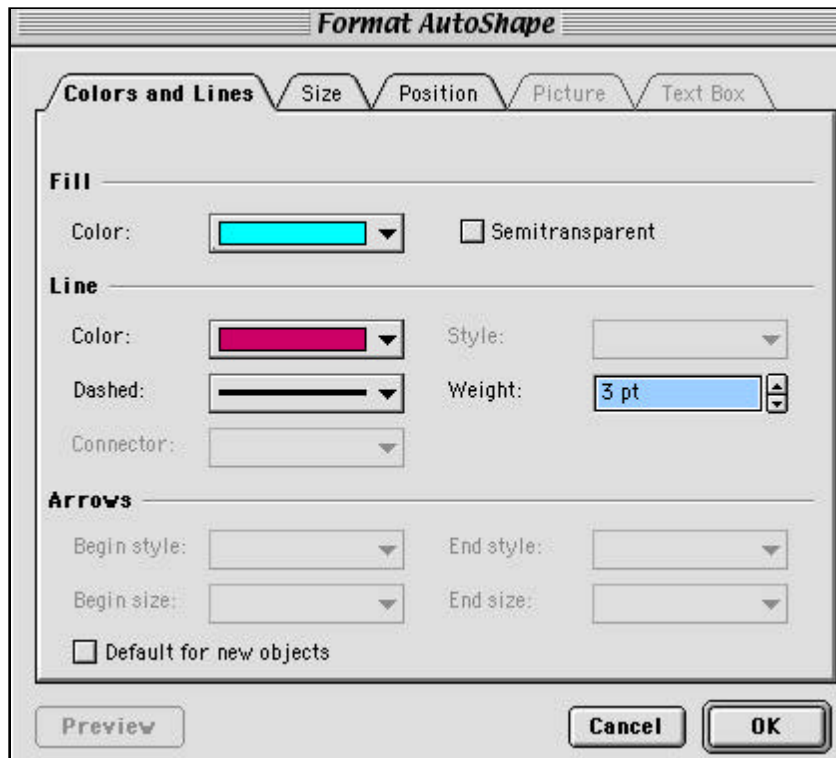


**NOTE:** you can even have the button launch another program such as an Internet browser.

9. Make a selection as to the action of the button.



10. To make changes to the appearance of the button, double click on the button. The following window appears:



11. If you want to have a transparent button that sits over a graphic or text, select **No Fill** under **Fill Color** and **Line Color**.
