Transition: School to Adult Life

- Program will include support to the Family/Caregivers.
- Seminar Series covering topics of Independent Living.
- Summers Conference Series will present topics supplemental to the Seminar Series and will take place at relevant sites across the Lehigh Valley.
- Project supervised by a Transition Program Advisory Committee composed of numerous collaborative partners.
